Inaugural Vintage!

2014 Napa Valley Estate Four Reds

Winemaker notes:

60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 17% Petit Verdot, 15% Merlot, and 8% Cabernet Franc

It is a lighter, more accessible, but well structured version of our traditional Cabernet, with the true Bordeaux traits of herbs and forest floor to go with its berry fruit. It remains typically Storybook in its clean, focused mouth feel that avoids sweetness, providing instead, a flavorful rendering of Bordeaux's unique savory yet fruity combination. Robert Parker described this wine as "deep and flavorful".

Vineyard:

The magic paradigm matching grape and terroir has always been our goal. Since 1994, we have selected the coolest areas and lightest soils as best for Cabernet Sauvignon, lower sections with heavier soils as ideal for Merlot, and appropriate hills and hollows for Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot. Different clones, rootstocks and cultural practices provide further fine tuning for each site. The result? As one reviewer put it, "over achieving Cabernet" has joined classic Zinfandel at Storybook Mountain.
